### **IMPORTANT RULES AND REQUESTS**

- \* **Fellers only!** You must mix, bake, assemble, and decorate your cake with absolutely no help from any female-types. Pick a feller to help you out and enjoy some time together: father, grandfather, brother, uncle, cousin, friend, or neighbor.
- \* **Put your cake on cardboard.** *Don't put your cake on a plate (or anything you'd want to keep).* Remember, this is an auction; your cake might go home with someone else.
- \* **The entire cake must be 100% edible.** No exceptions! That means you, too! You can't use toothpicks to hold it together, or Legos, or anything else that can't be eaten. Violation of this rule disqualifies the cake from ribbons or other awards.
- \* **Yes, you can use a store-bought mix** (or make it from scratch).
- \* **Identify your Cake/Category at check-in.** When you arrive at the check-in table, print your name, entry number and category on the entry form and attach it to your cake. If you want to tell the judges about your Cake, put that on the card, too. (For example, in the Healthiest Cake category, you might mention the healthful ingredients since the judges won't be tasting the cakes.)
- \* **Do your best!** Each Scout should feel proud of his creation and should know that it benefits his Pack.
